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Recent Evolution of Therapy in Neuropathy

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Peripheral neuropathy encompasses a variety of pathological and etiological disturbances involving peripheral nerves. Underlying pathologic mechanism was unveiled in some acquired neuropathies, permitting therapeutic management. However, most of neuropathies represent an unmet need for patients as well as neurologists yet due to the lack of treatment that can recover or halt the relentless progression of neurologic deficits.

Over the past decade, many therapies have been evaluated experimentally and in clinical trials for both inherited and acquired peripheral neuropathies.

This lecture will introduce new developments and the therapeutic opportunities for the management of peripheral neuropathies.

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
